The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder

shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

5. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three financial years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. The turnover of the bidder shall be validated by the system based on the financial data available on the GeM portal. The average turnover shall be calculated based on the last three financial years where data is available; in case data is available for only two of the last three financial years, the average shall be computed based on those two years. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than three years old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution / incorporation shall be taken into account for this criterion. No separate documentary evidence is required to be uploaded by the bidder for this criterion, as the system shall derive and validate the turnover figures from the data available on the GeM portal.

6. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

7. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

8. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

9. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

10. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.

- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1

1. Generic

8. Certificates

All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

The technical specifications are to be read in conjunction with the above and in case of variations; technical specifications of tender document shall apply. Nothing extra shall be paid on account of additional features in the technical specifications as the same are to be read along with schedule of quantities for the work..
2. Perspective tenderer shall visit the site and acquaint him with site condition, existing restriction in movement, working hours', security aspects, condition of electrical installation, Sub Station, DG Set, and UPS etc. before submission of tender. No complaint for loss of labour/unserviceable position of equipment shall be entertained at later stage on this account.
3. Tenderer shall provide the staff for running the installation as per requirement and should bear minimum qualification as prescribed in tender documents.
4. The skilled staff deployed by the contractor should have valid competency certificate for Electrical work.
5. The Contractor shall have valid electrical contractor's license. His electrical license should remain valid during contract as well as extended period of the contract/agreement failing which his agreement shall be terminated and no claim for payment shall be entertained by the department.
6. Other agencies working at site will also simultaneously execute the work entrusted to them and to their working; the contractor shall offer necessary cooperation wherever required to other agencies.
7. On account of security consideration, there could be some restrictions on the working hours, movement of vehicles for transportation of materials and location of labour camp. The contractor shall be bound to follow all such restrictions and adjust the programme for execution of works accordingly.
8. Unless otherwise specified, the agreement rates for all items of work of the Schedule of Quantities are for all heights, depths, leads and lifts involved in the execution of work.
9. The work shall be carried out in a manner complying in all respects with the requirements of relevant byelaws of the local bodies, labour laws, Minimum Wages Act, Workmen Compensation Act and other statutory laws enacted by Central Govt. as well as State Govt.

10. No residential accommodation shall be provided to any of the staff engaged by the contractor. The contractor shall also not be allowed to erect any temporary set up for his staff in the campus.

11. Rate quoted should be inclusive of all taxes including GST, labour cess, other local levy and net. Nothing extra shall be payable to contractor on this account.

12. No Claim of the labour shall be entertained by the University including that of providing employment, regularization of services etc.

13. Suitable space for store shall be provided by the department to the contractor free of cost. Electric connection for general purposes at the service centre shall be provided to contractor free of cost. Bills for the electricity consumed shall be paid by the GSV, Vadodara. Furniture such as tables, Almira's, lockers and chairs etc. to be arranged by vendor. The contractor shall be fully responsible for the safe custody of the material issued or brought to the site by him for doing the work.

14. All T&P including ladders, Scaffoldings, drill machine, megger (For LT&HT Both work), earth resistance tester, Sound Level Meter, clip on meter, Multi meter, Ring, fix, adjustable, Box Spanner set, Allen key set, Lux meter, wire drawing equipment's, chase cutting equipment's blower, spirit level gauge, crimping toolkit, Vernier caliper, Wire gauge, required for the work shall have to be arranged by the contractor. No T&P shall be issued by the department.

15. Condition for collection/ disposal of malba / building rubbish

Any malba / building rubbish generated during working by the contractor of this work is to be removed from the site within 24 hours and to be stacked at a pre-designated place. In case of failure to meet these deadlines a lump sum amount of Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred only) per complaint per day will be recovered from his bills / security deposit for every default to attend the complaints assigned to him. Dismantled material shall be taken away and disposed by the contractor at his cost or shall be deposited to department as per direction of Engineer-in-charge or his authorized representative. Nothing extra shall be paid or recovered on account of this.

16. GSV Campus is neat and clean campus. Hence, Chewing, spitting tobacco and smoking are strictly prohibited in the premises. If any worker found using this GSV shall take suitable action against him.

17. All materials, T&P, consumable (except provisions of BOQ/Approved Make list) and contingent articles required for the work shall be arranged by the contractor. Materials used shall be in preferences as Under the Nomenclature of the item.

ISI marked.

CPWD specifications.

CPWD approved.

Direction of the Engineer-in-charge

18. Staff employed by the contractor should be well behaved and any complaint of misbehaviour shall be taken very seriously and such staff will have to be removed by the contractor immediately from the site. Skilled staff employed shall must be able to execute the work without aid of helper.

19. The contractor shall make all safety arrangements required for the labour engaged by him at his cost. In case of any accident during work, operation equipment leading to injuries, damages to human being, equipment, loss of life the contractor shall be fully responsible for settling all claims and indemnify the department against any claim arising out of such accident.

20. Contractor shall be fully responsible for any damages caused to govt. property or allottee's property by him or his labour in carrying out the work and shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost.

21. TDS, GST TDS, Labour Cess and other taxes as applicable shall be recovered from the contractor's bill.

22. Chases, holes etc. shall be done using power-operated tools.

23. All the materials shall be got approved from engineer-in-charge before use at site.

24. After completion of work the contractor shall handover the all installation back to in university in working order and defect free condition. In case handing over is not made in above manner the defect shall be rectified by the university at the cost of contractor and necessary recovery shall be affected from his final bill.

25. Materials used for replacement shall have same or richer specifications to the original materials and should be compatible to the work.

26. All the dismantle materials shall be taken back by the contractor.

27. Any damage done by the contractor to any existing item / any part of the building during the course of execution of work shall be made good by at his own cost.

28. No payment shall be made to the contractor for any damage caused by the rain, snowfall or any other natural causes whatsoever during of work.

29. University reserves the right to remove any person deployed by the firm, without assigning any reason/notice. This will be without prejudice to the right of the contractor to remove any of his own employees deployed in the university.

30. Contractor shall ensure that the people are punctual and disciplined and remain vigilant in the performance of their duty.

31. In case of the persons so deployed by the contractor does not come up to the mark or does not perform his/her duties properly or indulges in any unlawful activities or riots or disorderly conduct, the contractor shall immediately withdraw and take suitable action against such persons on the report of the Engineer-in-charge. Further, the

contractor shall immediately replace the particular person so deployed on the demand of the Engineer-in-charge, in case of any of the aforesaid acts on the part of the said person.

32. Engineer-in-charge or any other person authorized by him shall be at liberty to carry out a surprise check on the persons so deployed by the contractor to ensure that the persons deployed by him are doing their duties.

SAFETY MEASURES

- 1.1.1 The issue of construction safety & standards has gained utmost importance in recent times. Contractors must follow highest safety standards and “ZERO” tolerance towards any violation of safety norms at the construction site. All workers of contractor and associate agencies, invariably and at all the times, must follow all safety norms, adopt best safe work practices as per requirement of job and use all required safety gadgets in their working throughout the project duration.
- 1.1.2 The contractor has to follow all safety norms as laid down in National Building Code of India. All the workers shall be equipped with the required safety gadgets while working at site such as ISI marked helmets, Shoes and safety belts, gumboots, gloves etc.
- 1.1.3 The contractor, the authorized representative(s), workmen etc., shall strictly observe orders pertaining to fire precautions prevailing in the area.
- 1.1.4 The contractor shall be fully responsible for the safe custody of materials brought by him/ issued to him even though the materials may be under double lock key system.
- 1.1.5 Contractor will arrange proper metal ladders, M.S. double scaffolding (for working, painting ,etc. at higher levels) at his own cost and will take all safety measures like double harness safety belt, mechanized electrically operated platform etc. If it is observed that work is proceeding without adequate safety precautions, work may be stopped by Engineer-in- charge and in such cases, contractor will be solely responsible for delay and its consequences thereof.
- 1.1.6 The contractor shall be responsible for the watch and ward/guard of the buildings, safety of all fittings and fixtures including sanitary and water supply fittings and fixtures provided by him against pilferage and breakage during the period of installations and thereafter till the building is physically handed over to the department. No extra payment shall be made on this account.
- 1.1.7 The contractor shall take all precautions to avoid accidents by exhibiting necessary caution boards day and night speed limit boards red flags, red lights and providing barriers. He shall be responsible for all dangers and incidents caused to existing / new work due to negligence on his part. No hindrances shall be caused to traffic during the execution of the work.
- 1.1.8 It shall be ensured by the contractor that no electric live wire is left exposed or unattended to avoid any accidents in this regard.
- 1.1.9 The University shall not have any responsibility or liability in case of any accident injury to the personnel to the contractor at work site or to the general public at the work site due to mishandling/malfunction of equipment by the personnel of the contractor or any other reason. The responsibilities and liabilities for such accidents and incidents shall be borne by the contractor. The contractor shall take all precautions for safety of the workmen. If any accident/ mis-happening occur the department shall not be responsible for the same. If any compensation is to be paid to the victim, the firm shall pay the same and no claim in this account shall be entertained by the department.

Note: 1 The special conditions detailed above are in addition to general, other and additional conditions as specified elsewhere in tender document.

Note : 2 Nothing extra shall be paid on the account of these special conditions.

The Engineer-in Charge can stop the work and seek removal of any workers from site in case of non-adoption of safety measures. Failure to provide such safety requirement would make the tenderer liable for penalty for Rs. 200/- for each violation.

Additional and Commercial Conditions

1. General

1.1 The work shall be executed as per CPWD General Specifications for Electrical Works (Part-III-LITS & Escalators) - 2003 and amended up to date, CPWD General Specifications for Electrical Works (Part I – Internal) 2023, (Part II -External) 2023, local body rules as amended up-to-date and Bombay Lift Act 1958 as amended up-to-date wherever applicable, as per relevant IS and as per directions of Engineer-in-Charge. The technical specifications are to be read in conjunction with the above and in case of variations; technical specifications of tender document shall apply. Nothing extra shall be paid on account of additional features in the technical specifications as the same are to be read along with schedule of quantities for the work.

1.2 The Department shall not issue any T & P and nothing extra shall be paid on account of this.

1.3 The work to be awarded by this tender shall be treated as indivisible works contract.

2. Terms of payment:

Payment shall be made as mention in schedule F. Bidder should note that necessary documents to be submitted as soon as the work is awarded to them. Payment shall be processed after submission of Invoice and necessary documents / certificates Bidder shall have to comply all necessary documents as outlined in the Contract as to be desired by the Accountant & Engineer In- Charge. It may take one to two months in the whole process (from submission / acceptance of bill in CMB / MB by the contractor upto processing by Accounts section) to release payment subject to quick compliance of all submittals by the contractor. Applicable Taxes shall be got deducted from the bill as per prevailing orders of the Government.

3. Rates:

The rates quoted by the tenderer, shall be firm and inclusive of GST & all other taxes, duties, levies and all charges for packing forwarding, insurance, freight and delivery, installation, testing, commissioning at site, risks, overhead charges, ESIC, Bonus (if applicable), EPF, general liabilities / obligations etc. Nothing Extra shall be paid on this account.

4. Completeness of tender:

All sundry equipment, fittings, unit assemblies, accessories, hardware items, foundation bolts, termination lugs for electrical connections, making hole, making openings in wall for installation work, and all other items which are useful and necessary for efficient assembly and installation of equipment and components of the work shall be deemed to have been included in the tender irrespective of the fact whether such items are specifically mentioned in the tender documents or not.

5A. Inspection and Testing:

Lift shall be inspected annually by the manufacturer's representative (other than the routine Service Engineer), and report of the status of healthiness shall be submitted.

5B. Storage and custody of materials:

The Control room/Store room may be used for storage of sundry materials and erection equipment if available or else the agency has to make their own arrangement. Watch and ward of the stores and their safe custody shall be the responsibility of the contractor till the final taking over of the installation by the department.

6. Care of the Building:

Care shall be taken by the contractor while handling and maintaining the various equipment's and components of the work to avoid damage to the building. They shall be responsible for repairing all damages and restoring the same to their original finish at their cost. They shall also remove at their cost all unwanted and waste materials arising out of the installation from the site of work.

7. Completion period:

The completion period indicated in the tender documents is for the entire work.

8. Performance Guarantee:

The Tenderer shall guarantee, among other things, compliance with the following specifications and performance requirements:

1. Quality and Standards

The goods, materials, or services offered shall be of the highest quality and shall conform in all respects to the technical specifications, drawings, and standards prescribed in the tender documents.

2. Performance and Functionality

The equipment or system supplied shall perform reliably and efficiently under normal operating conditions, meeting or exceeding the performance parameters stated in the specifications.

3. Workmanship and Materials

All materials, components, and workmanship shall be new, of approved quality, and free from defects in design, material, and workmanship.

4. Compliance with Regulations

The goods and services shall comply with all relevant national and international standards, safety regulations, and environmental requirements applicable to their use.

5. Warranty

The Tenderer shall warrant that the supplied goods/equipment shall remain free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of minimum 12 Months from the date of commissioning or acceptance.

6. Replacement of Defective Items

Any defective or non-conforming item discovered during the warranty period shall be repaired or replaced by the Tenderer at no additional cost.

9. Power Supply:

Power Supply for the purpose of Installation of plant and equipment shall be provided by GSV from some predefined point. However, making arrangement of safe connection for use of supply, to the satisfaction of Engineer in Charge shall be responsibility of contractor.

10 Security Deposit:

Security deposit @ 2.5% of the value of work done shall be recovered from all intermediate payments. The same shall be refunded to the contractor after one month of completion of work or after releasing the final payment, whichever is earlier.

11. After Award of Work:

The Contractor shall prepare the programme chart for the maintenance of Lifts for the work, showing clearly all activities from the start of work to the completion. The contractor shall submit a schedule for maintenance as prescribed by the manufacturer. The Contractor shall also submit their programme for various maintenance activities to the Institute for approval. Monthly programme and progress reports, and update / reschedule the same shall be submitted every month by the contractor

12. Extent of work:

The work shall comprise of entire labour including supervision and all materials necessary to maintain the installation mentioned under scope of work.

13. Compliance with Regulations and Indian standards

All works shall be carried out in accordance with relevant regulation, both statutory and those specified by the Indian Standards related to this work. In particular, the equipment and installation shall comply with the following:

- a. Factories Act
- b. Indian Electricity Rules
- c. I.S. & BS Standards as applicable
- d. Workmen's compensation Act
- e. Statutory norms prescribed by local bodies

Nothing in this tender shall be construed to relieve the successful tenderer of their responsibility for the design, manufacture and installation of the equipment with all accessories in accordance with currently applicable statutory regulations and safety codes.

14. Indemnity:

The successful tenderer shall at all times indemnify the department, consequent on this works contract. The successful tenderer shall be liable, in accordance with the Indian Law and Regulations for any accident occurring due to any cause and the contractor shall be responsible for any accident or damage incurred or claims arising there from during the period of operation and maintenance under the supervision of the successful tenderer. The successful tenderer shall take necessary actions in this regard. No extra payment would be made to the successful tenderer on account of the above. The successful tenderer shall also provide all insurance, including third-party insurance, as may be necessary to cover the risk

15. Order of Preference:

Should there be any difference or discrepancy between the description of items as given in the Schedule of Quantities, technical specifications for individual items of work (including additional and commercial conditions), other matters, IS Codes etc., the following order of preference shall be followed:

1. Schedule of quantities
2. Additional and Commercial Conditions
3. Technical specifications specified in the tender (Scope of work and Schedule of Maintenance)
4. General Condition
5. General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Works
6. Drawings
7. CPWD General Specifications
8. Relevant IS or any other International code in case IS code is not available
9. Decision of Engineer In-charge

Scope of work and Schedule of Maintenance

1. The contractor shall be required to carry out attending of every call back on break downs, periodical tests and inspections once in a month, renewal of lift working license etc. which are required and directed by the lift inspector and those required by Gujarat lifts & Escalators act 2000 during the contract period for which nothing extra shall be paid.
2. There shall be no limit for attending breakdown calls.
3. All-inclusive comprehensive maintenance includes taking over of the lift installation completely on as is where basis and doing all routine, periodic maintenance as per the manufacturer's schedule and replacement and repairs of parts/equipment of these complete installations by original equipment/parts as and when required. Contractor shall not only attend to the complaint but also rectify the cause of failure after investigation.
4. The firm shall be responsible to carry out the following but not limited to except otherwise stated, free of cost during maintenance contract, repair/replacement of:
 - A . All parts of main control panel i.e. relay, relay coils, moving contract/ fixed contact, landing locks, rectifiers, transformer, indicating light, rewinding of motor, transformer, Earthing of Lifts and all other items related with lift covered under maintenance.
 - B. Replacement / Repair of control board of lift, DC motor, Display Button, AC motor, gear box, DC generator, safety devices, ARD of all lifts, batteries of ARD,UPS, Batteries, indication lamps, guide rail, steel ropes, flywheel sheave, Sensors etc.
5. All types of Liaoning with local body authority in case of any accident of human being in the Lift etc. shall be the responsibility of the Agency.
6. The existing parts required to be replaced shall be replaced with existing make and specifications of the part. The rates agreed for comprehensive maintenance will be such that the dismantled material will not be returned to the department. However the dismantle material will be removed from site only after approval of Engineer In charge.
7. The demonstration of the functioning of ARD shall be conducted once in every month and it will be witnessed by the representative of the department. Failure of the ARD system or failure to conduct demonstration shall attract a penalty of Rs. 500/-per instance.
8. The rates quoted by the contractor should include all taxes, duties nothing extra shall be paid for the same.
9. The Agency has to ensure and provide all Electrical protection systems for the control Panel & their accessories, all lift installations in the Lift to prevent any major faults/damages from the Power Supply Company.

10. All the consumable materials should be provided by the OEM under AMC Work. Nothing extra shall be payable on this account.

11. Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract shall cover the following –

1. Diagnose the faults and rectify the defect detected in reasonable time.
2. Repair / replace the faulty parts etc. of the equipment.
3. Carry out the periodic preventive maintenance as per the schedules.
4. Upkeep of the system, recording and maintaining works carried out and submission of report to Engineer In Charge.
5. The contractor shall be solely responsible for the maintenance, repair, replacements and supply of required parts etc.

The lift shall be maintained with all spares (material replacement if required) as per schedule laid down below

PENALTY CLAUSE –

1. In case the lift remains idle for more than 24 hours due to any failure/reason, except for power supply, a penalty at the rate of ₹ 250.00 per day shall be deducted in addition to the AMC charges.
2. If replacement of any part is involved and more time is required for its replacement, then it should be brought to the notice of the Engineer-in-charge and a new deadline will be set. In such case no penalty will be imposed till the new deadline, but in case the new deadline is not met, a penalty of ₹ 250.00 per day shall be levied.

The firm shall make arrangement in such a way that after a failure call registered –

(a) The failure shall be attended within two (02) hours' time, in case it occurs during daytime.

(b) In case the failure occurs in the night time, it shall be attended next day in the morning.

(c) In case of any emergency situation, the firm shall attend to the complaint/failure **immediately and on a priority basis**, particularly in cases where a person is trapped/stuck inside the lift.

MONTHLY SCHEDULE

1. Check all safety shoes/door detectors/sensors and open button and set right.
2. Check all CPI (Car Position Indicator), CDI (Car Direction Indicator) and DOB (Door Open/Call Buzzer) and set right.
3. Check alarm bell circuit, emergency light and intercom, push and talk system and set right.
4. Check condition of the car equipment, especially lights and fans and set right.
5. Check/observe starting/stopping at floor levels, and correct it/adjust it as per requirement.
6. Check oil level in motor generator set sleeve, bearing and machine gear box.

7. Check/grease governor deflector pulley and set in order.
8. Check Motor and Gear box set, if needed sleeve bearing and machine gearbox. Check oil level in machine gearbox, top up/replace if required.
9. Check Motor for overheating; if required, motor winding repairs or rewinding or motor replacement are in the scope of work.
10. Check AC Switches for proper contact; if required, repair/replace.
11. Check door operations and door interlock; if required, adjust as per requirement.
12. Check car gate switch and all UP and DOWN final switches; if required, repair/replace.
13. Check suspension ropes and over-speed governor rope and set right.
14. Clean car top area and lubricate guide rails.
15. Clean the pit and hoist way.
16. Clean machine room equipment like brake liner and replace if required.
17. For safe working, check over-speed governor roller and if any wear and tear is found, it should be repaired or replaced.
18. In machine room, open the lift control panel. Use a blower to remove all dust. Check all wiring for any overheating or melting, proper working of indication lamps, relays, timers, and microprocessor-based cards. All these items are to be thoroughly checked and if any abnormality is found, it should be repaired or replaced as per need.
19. Check the V3F drive system. If any modification is required or any defective part of V3F is found, the microprocessor card (V3F drive system) should be repaired or replaced and is included in the scope of work.
20. Check alarm switch and ensure proper functioning.
21. Check car operation panel with infrared door detector device. If found defective, repair or replace it.
22. Check all operations from inside and outside the car in "Auto" and "Attendant" modes. If any defect is noticed, it should be duly attended.
23. Check lift for any jerking and check micro leveling switch. This is a critical and important aspect and must conform to Gujarat Lift and Elevator Act.
24. Check the overload relay. Replace if required.
25. All car locking devices must be checked and replaced or repaired if required.
26. All safety devices must be checked—limit switches, over-travel switches, top/bottom electromechanical interlocks, over-speed governor mechanism—and repaired or replaced if required.
27. Check and repair emergency landing device/automatic rescue device. If defects are found in UPS/Batteries/ARD cards, repair or replace the same.

In short, all parts in the lift, control panel, and machine room equipment are to be thoroughly checked and serviced. If any part fails or is defective, the replacement/repair is considered to be in the scope of work.

Once monthly maintenance services are carried out as per the contract, entries must be made in a register and signed by the firm's representative and the Engineer-in-charge or his representative of the GSV.

YEARLY MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

1. All monthly services should be carried out.
 2. Overhauling and servicing of all major parts should be done in accordance with the Gujarat Lift and Elevator Act.
 3. As per Gujarat Lift & Escalator Act 2000, statutory inspection of lift is required to be done every year by a third party. The lift shall be physically fit to pass through this inspection. No extra payments shall be made on this & to be arranged by contractor. Renewal of Lift License is in the scope of contractor.
 4. Overhauling of all equipment/panels in lift car, machine room, pit, and control panel shall be done thoroughly. Any defective part shall be attended/repaired or replaced, which is included in the scope of work.
 5. Shut down shall be arranged for work by GSV.
 6. Once yearly maintenance service is completed as per the contract, entries must be made in the register and jointly signed by the representative of the firm and Engineer-in-charge or his representative of the GSV.
-
12. The firm must inspect the lift installation before quoting. The bidder is deemed to have full knowledge of the installation, inspected or not.
 13. The firm shall provide facilities for their staff to contact in emergencies.
 14. Only authorized staff shall perform servicing/overhauling.
 15. The contract includes all major and minor repairs with spares and accessories for breakdowns.
 16. Gati Shakti Vishwavidyalaya reserve the right to terminate the contract without reason if services are unsatisfactory.
 17. Safety and security of contractor's employees rest with the contractor.
 18. All replaced parts shall be genuine standard make or OEM.
