If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 6. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

7. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

8. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

9. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.

ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS (ATC)

The Service Provider shall ensure compliance with the following conditions. The cost of all such requirements shall be deemed to be included in the quoted rates (Tender Value).

- The driver shall be properly dressed in uniform consisting of **white shirt, white trousers, black shoes, and a cap** bearing the agency's name and logo (if applicable).
- In the event of a vehicle breakdown, a replacement vehicle shall be provided within **30 minutes** at the location specified by the Buyer. Failure to provide a replacement vehicle within the stipulated time a penalty of ₹1,000 per incident shall be imposed and deducted from the running bill, along with a warning issued to the service provider.
- For outstation journeys, **toll tax and parking charges** shall be reimbursed separately upon submission of original toll and parking receipts along with the running bill.
- The vehicle shall be clean, well-maintained, and equipped with basic amenities such as **clean napkins, air freshener, tissue papers, and other essential consumables**.
- The registered office of the Service Provider preferably be located at consignee location or within the same State. In case a registered office is not presently available, the bidder shall establish within 21 days from the date of

award of contract.

6. GSV reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time during the contract period by giving **15 days' prior written notice**. The Service Provider may also terminate the contract by giving 15 days' prior notice. The contract may also be terminated by mutual consent.
7. The vehicle shall always carry a **fire extinguisher, first-aid kit and other mandatory safety equipment**, which shall be periodically checked and replaced before expiry.
8. The driver shall possess a valid driving licence and carry all relevant documents while on duty. A self-attested copy of the driving licence shall be submitted to the Buyer before commencement of services.
9. The vehicle shall have a valid **Registration Certificate (RC), Permit, Pollution Under Control (PUC) Certificate, and comprehensive insurance** covering vehicle damage, third-party liability, passengers, and property. All documents shall remain valid throughout the contract period.
10. Only **commercial vehicles with yellow registration number plates** shall be deployed. Deployment of any private vehicle shall attract a penalty of **₹1,000 per vehicle per day**.
11. A complete tool kit required for minor repairs and breakdown maintenance shall be available in the vehicle at all times and shall be subject to inspection by the Buyer.
12. The Service Provider shall raise invoices in accordance with the provisions of the **GST Act**.
13. Drivers shall not consume alcohol, tobacco, or any intoxicating substance during duty hours.
14. In case of outstation travel, **outstation night halt charges**, if applicable, shall be paid when the duty extends between **10:30 PM and 6:00 AM** at an outstation location, as per the approved rates.
15. The contract shall remain valid for **one (1) year** from the date of the Contract Order and may be extended for a further period of **one (1) year** on the same terms and conditions, subject to satisfactory performance of the Service Provider and approval of the Competent Authority.
16. Charges for additional kilometres beyond the prescribed limit shall be payable as per the applicable **Service Level Agreement (SLA)**.

Penalty Clause

17. The following penalties may be imposed on the Service Provider for failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the contract:
 - i. First instance of delayed reporting or failure to provide the vehicle: **₹500 per incident**.
 - ii. Second instance of delayed reporting or failure to provide the vehicle: **₹1,000 per incident**.
 - iii. Third instance of delayed reporting or failure to provide the vehicle: **₹2,000 per incident**.
 - iv. In case such default occurs more than three times, GSV reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to terminate the contract without any further notice and/or impose additional penalties as deemed appropriate.

The important clauses in case of accidents, fatalities, injuries, or any major mishap

18. **Contractor's Sole Responsibility Clause** : The contractor shall be solely responsible for the safety and security of drivers, co-passengers and any third party during operation of the vehicle. Any accident, injury, death, loss, or damage arising out of the operation of the vehicle shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
19. **Indemnity Clause** : The contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the University, its officers, employees, and staff against all claims, liabilities, losses, damages, compensation, legal proceedings, costs, and expenses arising from any accident, injury, death, negligence, or breach of statutory provisions during execution of the contract.
20. **Compensation Liability Clause** : Any compensation payable under the Motor Vehicles Act, Workmen Compensation Act, or any other applicable law due to an accident involving the hired vehicles shall be borne entirely by the contractor and the University shall have no financial liability whatsoever.
21. **Emergency Response Clause** : In case of any accident or emergency, the contractor shall immediately arrange medical assistance, inform the University authorities and local police, and take all necessary steps for rescue and rehabilitation of affected persons.
