### **1. Introduction**

Gati Shakti Vishwavidyalaya (GSV), Vadodara is a Central University established under the Central Universities (Amendment) Act, 2022 under the Ministry of Railways, Government of India. The Hon'ble President of India is the Visitor of the University, while the Hon'ble Union Minister of Railways serves as the Chancellor. The University has been envisioned as a premier institution of higher education and research



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dedicated to developing highly skilled professionals, researchers and innovators for the Transportation, Logistics and allied sectors in India and abroad.

To strengthen its research infrastructure and promote advanced research activities, GSV intends to establish a state-of-the-art Research & Development (R&D) Laboratory over an approximate built-up area of 9,000 sq. ft. at its campus in Vadodara.

At present, the proposed site contains an existing obsolete structure, debris and miscellaneous materials which shall be cleared by the successful bidder as part of the scope of work. A representative image of the proposed site is enclosed with the tender document for reference only.

The work shall be executed on a Turnkey Basis, wherein the successful bidder shall be responsible for carrying out all civil, structural, electrical, plumbing, fabrication and allied works, complete in all respects, so as to deliver a fully functional R&D laboratory ready for use by the University.

## 2. Broad Scope of Work

The broad scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Note: The above scope is indicative and not exhaustive. The successful bidder shall execute all works, whether specifically mentioned or otherwise required, for the complete and satisfactory execution and commissioning of the R&D Laboratory in accordance with the approved drawings, specifications, applicable codes and directions of the Competent Authority/Associate Dean (R&D), GSV.

### 3. General Conditions

1. The work shall be executed on a Turnkey Basis, and the quoted price shall be deemed to include all materials, services, labour, machinery, transportation,



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testing, commissioning, statutory approvals, taxes, duties, overheads and all incidental expenses necessary for successful completion of the project.

2. The quoted price shall be for one complete job, including all items/services required to make the R&D Laboratory fully functional and ready for use.
3. Though the project is on a Turnkey basis, all works shall be carried out in accordance with the CPWD Specifications, the National Building Code (NBC) of India, relevant Indian Standards (IS) Codes, and other applicable statutory provisions, as amended from time to time.
4. The bidder shall possess all valid registrations, licences and statutory approvals required for execution of the work, including but not limited to registration under the Labour Department, EPF, ESIC, GST, PAN and any other authority as applicable under law.
5. Compliance with all applicable labour laws, environmental regulations, safety requirements, building regulations and other statutory provisions shall be the sole responsibility of the successful bidder.
6. The contractor shall deploy technically qualified engineers, supervisors and skilled manpower necessary for proper execution of the work and shall ensure adherence to all safety standards during execution.
7. A Mandatory Site Visit/Pre-Bid Site Survey shall be conducted on the date specified in the tender schedule. All prospective bidders shall mandatorily attend the site visit.
8. Bidders failing to attend the mandatory site visit shall be treated as non-responsive, and their technical bids shall be summarily rejected.
9. During the site visit, bidders may seek clarifications regarding the scope of work. Any decision, clarification, modification or additional requirement finalized by GSV shall be communicated only through Corrigendum/Addendum and/or official email and shall form an integral part of the tender document.
10. Bidders shall submit their Technical and Financial Bids only after taking into consideration all corrigenda, clarifications, decisions and requirements communicated by GSV.
11. The successful bidder shall complete the entire work, including testing, commissioning and handing over, within the stipulated completion period of 180 days from the date of issuance of the Contract Order.
12. Any work, service, material or activity not specifically mentioned but necessary for the successful completion, safe operation, functionality and intended use of the R&D Laboratory shall be deemed to be included in the scope of the turnkey contract and shall be executed by the contractor without any additional financial implication to GSV.
13. The bidder should have a branch/registered office in the State of the Consignee, preferably in Vadodara, to facilitate effective coordination and timely completion of the project.



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## **4. Bid Submission & Evaluation Process**

### **4.1 Two-Packet Bid System**

The bidder shall submit its bid through the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) only, in the following two packets:

#### **Packet-I: Technical Bid**

The Technical Bid shall contain, inter alia:

1. Acceptance of all terms and conditions of the tender in the prescribed format.
2. Work Order/Contract Order regarding minimum three years' experience in execution of similar nature of works in any Central/State Government Department/Organisation, Autonomous Body, PSU.
3. Valid GST Registration Certificate.
4. PAN Card.
5. CA-certified/CA-authorised Average Annual Turnover for the last three financial years, i.e. FY 2022-23, FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25 should not be less than 80 Lakhs (Documentary proof is to be submitted by the bidder).
6. Mandatory Site Survey attendance/confirmation, as prescribed in the tender.
7. The bidder should not have been blacklisted, debarred or banned by any Central Government Department, State Government Department, PSU, Autonomous Body or Statutory Authority on the last date of submission of bids (Undertaking is to be submitted by the bidder in this regard).
8. Any other documents specified in the tender document.

#### **Packet-II: Financial Bid**

The Financial Bid shall contain only the financial offer in the prescribed format.

The bidder shall quote a single consolidated price for 1 Job, covering the complete scope of work required for establishment and commissioning of the R&D Laboratory on a turnkey basis.

### **4.2 Evaluation**

The Technical Bids shall first be evaluated for compliance with the eligibility criteria and technical requirements prescribed in the tender document.

Only those bidders who are found technically qualified shall be considered for opening/evaluation of their Financial Bids.

The contract shall be considered for award to the technically qualified bidder offering the lowest evaluated total price (L-1) for the complete turnkey project, subject to fulfilment of all tender conditions and approval of the Competent Authority.



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In the event of a tie in the evaluated total price quoted by two or more technically qualified bidders, the bidder having the higher average annual turnover during the last three financial years, i.e. FY 2022-23, FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25, shall be considered for award of the contract, subject to fulfilment of all other tender conditions.

## 5. Performance Bank Guarantee

1. The successful bidder shall submit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to 5% of the total Contract Value within 21 days from the date of issuance of the Contract Order.
2. The PBG shall remain valid for a period of 18 months from the date of issuance of the Contract Order, covering the stipulated completion period and the applicable contractual obligations of the contractor.
3. The PBG shall be furnished in the prescribed format and manner acceptable to Gati Shakti Vishwavidyalaya (GSV) and shall be issued by a bank acceptable to GSV.

## 6. Earnest Money Deposit:

1. The bidder shall submit an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of ₹3,37,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Thirty-Seven Thousand only) in the form of a Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) or Demand Draft (DD) issued by any Nationalized or Scheduled Bank and duly pledged in favour of "Gati Shakti Vishwavidyalaya, Vadodara".
2. Bids not accompanied by the prescribed EMD shall be liable to be rejected, except in the case of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) and Start-ups claiming exemption, subject to submission of valid documentary evidence and fulfilment of the eligibility conditions prescribed under the applicable Government of India rules.
3. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded, without interest, after finalization of the tender/contract.

All part payments shall be released only after due verification and certification of the work by the Competent Authority/Associate Dean (R&D), GSV. In case of delay in completion beyond the stipulated completion period of 180 days from the date of issuance of the Contract Order, Liquidated Damages (LD) shall be applicable at the rate of 0.5% of the total Contract Value per week or part thereof, subject to a maximum of 10% of the total Contract Value, as per the terms and conditions of the tender/contract.

Any request for advance payment shall not be entertained by GSV.

## 8. Safety Requirements

The contractor shall be solely responsible for the safety of workers, materials, equipment and the work site during execution. Any accident occurring during execution shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.

## 9. Price Variation

No escalation on account of increase in labour wages, material prices, taxes (except statutory variation, if specifically, admissible), exchange rate fluctuation or any other reason whatsoever shall be admissible during the currency of the contract.



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## **10. Completion and Handing Over**

Upon completion of the work, the contractor shall:

- Conduct testing and commissioning of all systems.
- Rectify all defects.
- Clean the site.
- Remove all temporary structures.
- Submit completion drawings (if applicable).
- Submit warranties and guarantees (if applicable).

## **11. Defect Liability Period:**

The Defect Liability Period (DLP) shall be 12 months from the date of issuance of the Completion Certificate upon successful completion of the work. Any defect arising during the Defect Liability Period shall be rectified by the Contractor at their own cost, including all associated material, labour, and workmanship expenses.

## **12. Termination**

GSV reserves the right to terminate the contract, wholly or partly, by giving written notice in the event of:

- Failure to commence work.
- Unsatisfactory progress.
- Persistent breach of contract conditions.
- Abandonment of work.
- Insolvency or liquidation of the contractor.
- Submission of false information/documents.
- Blacklisting during the currency of the contract.

Upon termination, GSV shall be entitled to get the remaining work executed at the risk and cost of the contractor.

## **13. Dispute Resolution**

Any dispute arising out of or relating to this contract shall first be resolved through mutual discussion between the parties.

If the dispute remains unresolved, the matter shall be referred to the Vice Chancellor, Gati Shakti Vishwavidyalaya or an officer authorised by him for amicable resolution.

In case the dispute still remains unresolved, the courts at Vadodara, Gujarat shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

## **14. Steps for Execution of the Turnkey Project**



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The turnkey project shall broadly be executed in the following sequence:

- a) Publication of Tender on CPPP
- b) Mandatory Site Survey/Physical Inspection by the Bidders
- c) Submission of Technical and Financial Bids
- d) Technical and Financial Evaluation of Bids and Award of Contract
- e) Submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) by the Successful Bidder
- f) Commencement and Execution of the Turnkey Works
- g) Testing, Commissioning and Rectification of Deficiencies, if any
- h) Completion, Inspection and Handing Over of the R&D Laboratory to GSV
- i) Verification and Certification of Completed Work.
- j) Release of Payment as per the Tender/Contract Terms and Conditions

## **INTEGRITY PACT**

Between [the **Procuring Organisation**] hereinafter referred to as "The Principal," and \_\_\_\_\_ hereinafter referred to as "The Bidder/ Contractor."

### **Preamble**

The Principal intends to award contract/s for \_\_\_\_\_, under laid down organisational procedures. The Principal values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economical use of resources, and fairness / transparency in its relations with its Bidder(s) and / or Contractor(s).

To achieve these goals, the Principal shall appoint Independent External Monitors (IEMs) who shall monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned above.

### **Section 1 – Commitments of the Principal**

1. The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles: a. No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, shall in connection with the tender for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to. b. The Principal shall treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason during the tender process. The Principal shall, in particular, before and during the tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and shall not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in the tender process or the contract execution. c. The Principal shall exclude from the process all known persons having conflict of interest.
2. If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the IPC/PC Act, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal shall inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition shall initiate disciplinary proceedings.

### **Section 2 – Commitments of the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s)**

1. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) commits themselves to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) commits themselves to observe the following principles during participation in the tender process and the contract execution: a. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) shall not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise, or give to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of the contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which they are not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or the execution of the contract. b. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) shall not enter with other Bidders into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal, in violation of the Competition Act, 2002 (as amended from time to time). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelisation in the tender process. c. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) shall not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act; further, the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) shall not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals, and business details, including information contained or

transmitted electronically. d. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the Agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly, the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principals, if any. Further details, as mentioned in the "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers," shall be disclosed by the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s). Further, as mentioned in the Guidelines, all the payments made to the Indian agent/representative must be in Indian Rupees only. Copy of the "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers" is placed on Annex hereto. e. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) shall, when presenting their bid, disclose any and all payments made, is committed to, or intends to make to agents, brokers, or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract. f. Bidder(s) /Contractor(s) who have signed the Integrity Pact shall not approach the Courts while representing the matter to IEMs and shall wait for their decision.

2. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) shall not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

### **Section 3 – Disqualification from the tender process and exclusion from future contracts**

If the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s), before award or during execution, has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2, above or in any other form such as to put their reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from the tender process or take action as per laid down procedure to debar the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) from participating in the future procurement processes of the Government of India.

### **Section 4 – Compensation for Damages**

1. If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process before the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/ Bid Security.
2. If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages of the Contract value or the amount equivalent to Performance Bank Guarantee.

### **Section 5 – Previous transgression**

1. The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last three years with any other Company in any country conforming to the anti-corruption approach or with any Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.
2. If the Bidder makes an incorrect statement on this subject, the Principal shall act like para 2) of Section 4 above.

### **Section 6 – Equal treatment of all Bidders / Contractors / Subcontractors**

In the case of Sub-contracting, the Principal Contractor shall take responsibility for adopting the Integrity Pact by the Sub-contractor. a. The Principal shall enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders and Contractors. b. The Principal shall disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this Pact or violate its provisions.

### **Section 7 – Criminal charges against violating Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) / Subcontractor(s)**

If the Principal obtains knowledge of the conduct of a Bidder, Contractor, or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an allied firm of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal shall inform the same to the Chief Vigilance Officer.

#### **Section 8 – Independent External Monitor**

1. The Principal shall appoint competent and credible Independent External Monitor(s) for this Pact after approval by the Central Vigilance Commission. The task of the Monitor is to review, independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
2. The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the parties' representatives and performs their functions neutrally and independently. The Monitor would have access to all Contract documents whenever required. It shall be obligatory for them to treat the information and documents of the Bidders/Contractors as confidential. They report to the Management of the Principal.
3. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction, all Project documentation of the Principal, including that provided by the Contractor. Upon their request and demonstration of a valid interest, the Contractor shall also grant the Monitor unrestricted and unconditional access to their project documentation. The same applies to Sub-contractors.
4. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s)/ Sub-contractor(s) with confidentiality. The Monitor has also signed declarations on 'Non-Disclosure of Confidential Information' and 'Absence of Conflict of Interest.' In case of any conflict of interest arising later, the IEM shall inform the Management of the Principal and recuse themselves from that case.
5. The Principal shall provide the Monitor with sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the Project, provided such meetings could impact the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
6. As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, they shall inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action or other relevant action. The Monitor can, in this regard, submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action, or tolerate action.
7. The Monitor shall submit a written report to the Management of the Principal, within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
8. If the Monitor has reported to the Management of the Principal a substantiated suspicion of an offence under the relevant IPC/ PC Act, and the Management of the Principal has not, within the reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner.
9. The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

**Section 9 – Pact Duration**

This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the contract, and for all other Bidders, 6 months after the contract has been awarded. Any violation of the same would entail disqualifying the bidders and exclusion from future business dealings. If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pact as specified above, unless it is discharged / determined by the Management of the Principal.

**Section 10 – Other provisions**

- 1. This agreement is subject to Indian Law. The place of performance and jurisdiction is the place from where the Tender/ Contract is issued.
- 2. Changes, supplements, and termination notices must be submitted in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 3. If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 4. Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties shall strive to come to an agreement according to their original intentions.
- 5. Issues like Warranty / Guarantee, etc., shall be outside the purview of IEMs.
- 6. In the event of any contradiction between the Integrity Pact and its Annex, the Clause in the Integrity Pact shall prevail.
